PURPOSE OF THE CALL FOR TENDERS

The General Manager of the Port Authority of Kribi (PAK), Project Owner, hereby launches a Call for Tenders to renew the IT licenses of the Port Authority of Kribi.

2. NATURE OF SERVICES

Services covered by this Call for Tenders shall include the renewal of PAK IT licenses which must meet the major technical specifications provided in the Supply Description.

3. PART/ALLOTMENT

This Call for Tenders shall not be divided. Services will be provided in instalments.

4. PROVISIONAL COST

The provisional cost for all the services is two hundred and eighty million (280,000,000) CFAF all tax inclusive.

5. PROVISIONAL EXECUTION AND PLACE OF DELIVERY

The maximum execution time provided for by the Project Owner to renew the PAK IT licenses shall be **four (4) months**.

This period shall run from the date of notification of the service order to start work. The delivery place is the site of the Port Authority of Kribi located in Kribi.

6. PARTICIPATION AND ORIGIN

This Call for Tenders is open to Cameroonian companies specialised in supplying IT licenses.

7. FUNDING

Services covered by this Call for Tenders shall be funded by the Budget of the Port Authority of Kribi, 2025 and 2026 FYs.

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8. SUBMISSION MODE

The submission mode chosen for this Call for Tenders is offline mode.

9. BID BOND

Bids must be accompanied by a bid bond issued by a financial institution approved by the Minister in charge of finance to issue bid bonds for public contracts (see Document 15 in the Tender File) and amounting to two million (2,000,000) CFAF to be automatically released no later than 30 days after the expiry of the validity of the tenders. Failure to provide a bid bond issued by a first-rate banking or financial institution approved by the Minister in charge of finance to issue bid bonds for public contracts, shall result in the outright rejection of the bid. A bid bond provided that has no relation with the Call for Tenders shall be considered as a failure to provide such bid bond.

A bid bond shall be deemed non-compliant in the following instances:

- A bid that does not mention the names of all the parties in the grouping. where applicable:
- A bid for which the guaranteed amount is lower than the amount required by the Specific Rules of the Call for Tenders;
- A bid that contains a material error likely to have an adverse effect on the legal effect intended.

The stamped bid bond must be accompanied by a deposit receipt issued by the Deposits and Consignment Fund (CDEC).

In addition, the information in the financial file (price sub-details, unit price list, cost estimate) will be provided on a USB key during the bid-opening session.

Each bid shall bear the following mention:

TO BE OPENED ONLY DURING THE BID-OPENING SESSION."

13. ADMISSIBILITY OF BIDS

Administrative documents, the technical file and the financial file must be placed in separate envelopes and submitted in a sealed envelope.

The Project Owner shall declare the following inadmissible:

- > envelopes bearing details of the bidders' identity;
- bids received after the deadline for submission (date and time);
- > Bids that do not comply with the principle of separating administrative, technical and financial files;
- bids that do not specify the Call for Tenders;
- bids that do not comply with the submission mode (as the submission is offline, all the bids that will not be submitted in hard copies in the condition provided in this Call for Tenders shall be inadmissible);
- > Failure to comply with the number of copies indicated in the Special Rules of the Call for Tenders or bid submitted only in copies.

Any bid deemed incomplete as per the requirements of the Tender File shall be declared inadmissible, namely for the lack of a bid bond issued by a first-rate banking or financial institution approved by the Minister in charge of finance to issue bid bonds for public contracts or for failure to comply with the templates specified in the Tender File, shall result in the outright rejection of the bid with no right of appeal. A bid bond provided that has no relation with the Call for Tenders shall be considered as a failure to provide such bid bond.

However, an administrative document, including the bid bond, submitted during the bid-opening session shall be admissible.

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14. OPENING OF BIDS

The opening of bids shall take place in one stage on _1_1_AUK__2U25 at 1 p.m. prompt by the Internal Procurement Committee of the Port Authority of Kribi in the conference room located on the 2nd floor of the PAK 2-storey building next to MEAO Building in Kribi.

Bidders or their duly mandated representatives shall attend this opening session. Such representatives must be one person per bidder even in the event the bidder is a consortium.

Under penalty of rejection, administrative documents required must be provided in originals or certified copies signed by the issuing institution or the competent administrative authority in accordance with the provisions of the Specific Rules of the Call for Tenders. They must have been issued less than three (3) months before the original date of submission of bids or after the signing date of the Callf or Tenders. Any bid whose administrative file is deemed incomplete, including the bid bond, after the 48h deadline provided by the Committee shall be declared inadmissible.

15. MAIN EVALUATION CRITERIA

1.1. ELIMINATORY CRITERIA

1) Insufficient number of copies (less than 7 copies)

2) Administrative file

- No bid bond when opening the bid;
- Non-compliant or incomplete administrative file 48 hour after the bidopening session (except for the bid bond);
- False statement, fraudulent manoeuvre or forged document.

3) Technical file

- No catalogue brochure, drawing or technical data sheet produced by the manufacturer;
- In case the supplier is not the manufacturer, no supplier's approval or authorisation issued by the manufacturer or no supplier's approval or authorisation issued by a dealer approved by the manufacturer accompanied by the dealer's approval;
- No authorisation or evidence to operate, in case the supplier is the manufacturer;
- Non-compliance with 80% of the technical specifications for supplies;
- Failure to meet 4 out of 5 essential criteria;

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- No Integrity Charter initialled on each page, stamped, dated and signed;
- No declaration of commitment to comply with the social and environmental clauses initialled on each page, stamped, dated and signed;
- No declaration of commitment to pay customs clearance costs and all transport-related charges;
- No Supply Description (SD) initialled on all pages, stamped, dated and signed;
- No Specific Administrative Specifications (CCAP) initialled on each page, stamped, dated and signed;
- False statement, fraudulent manoeuvre or forged document.

4) Financial file

- No quantified unit price;
- No sub-details on quantified unit prices;
- False statement, fraudulent manoeuvre or forged document.

1.2. KEY CRITERIA

The key criteria for the qualification of candidates shall focus on:

Any bid that does not meet all the eliminatory criteria and obtains at least fou4 (05) out of the five (05) evaluation criteria shall be eliminated.

16. AWARD

The Project Owner shall award the contract to the bidder with the bid that meets the required technical and financial qualification criteria and is evaluated as the most competitive bidder after proposed discounts if necessary.

17. VALIDITY OF BIDS

Bidders shall be bound by their tenders for ninety (90) days with effect from the tender submission deadline.
