



NATIONAL OPEN CALL FOR TENDERS No. 025/AONO/PAK/CIPM/2024 OF 08 MAI 2024 TO BUILD THREE (3) BOREHOLES IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS: ELOGBATINDI, FIFINDA II AND CAMPO BEACH WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE PROJECT TO IMPROVE ACCESS ROADS TO THE KRIBI INDUSTRIAL AND PORT ZONE (PARZIK).

FUNDING: African Development Bank (AfDB)/STATE OF CAMEROON

1. Purpose of the Call for Tenders

Within the framework of the project to improve access roads to the Kribi industrial and port zone (PARZIK), the General Manager of the Port Authority of Kribi, Deputy Project Owner acting for and on behalf of the STATE OF CAMEROON represented by the Ministry of Public Works, Project Owner, hereby launches a National Call for Tenders to build three (3) boreholes in the following areas: ELOGBATIDI ; FIFINDA II et CAMPO BEACH.

2. Nature of services

Services shall be the following:

Details of the work shall be set out in the Technical Specifications.

3. Provisional exécution time

The maximum time provided for by the Deputy Project Owner to carry out the work shall be **three (3) months for the work per se and twelve (12) months for the warranty period.**

4. Place of work

The boreholes shall be constructed in three localities in the South Region of Cameroon: a borehole at ELOGBATINDI, more precisely one (1) kilometre away from the town centre at a place called MBOCKE; a borehole at FIFINDA II, more precisely at the chiefdom at PK 32 on National Road No. 07, and a borehole at CAMPO BEACH.

5. Allotment

This Call for Tenders shall not be divided.

6. Provisional cost

The provisional cost after prior studies shall be **thirty-four million five hundred and eighty-two thousand five hundred (34,582,500) CFAF all tax inclusive.**

7. Participation and origin

This Call for Tenders is open to all companies or groups of companies with the required expertise incorporated under Cameroonian law.



8. Funding

Services covered by this Call for Tenders shall be funded by the **African Development Bank (AfDB) and the STATE OF CAMEROON**, in accordance with Loan Agreement No. 2000200005057 between the Republic of Cameroon and the African Development Bank.

9. Site visits and pre-bidding meeting

Site visits shall take place on 29 MAI 2024 for ELOGBATINDI and FIFINDA II and on 30 MAI 2024 for CAMPO BEACH.

PAK teams and bidders shall meet at the ELOGBATINDI Chiefdom at 7:2 on the first day. Bidders led by a team of the Deputy Project Owner shall visit the two (2) other sites in ELOGBATINDI and FIFINDA II. For the second day, PAK teams and bidders shall meet at the PAK 2-storey building next MEAO Building in Kribi at 08. The bidders, led by a team from the Delegate Project Owner, shall go in procession to the CAMPO BEACH works site.

Each bidder must provide his/her team with vehicles to go to the site. In accordance with the provisions of the General Rules of the Call for Tenders, each bidder shall incur expenses pertaining to the effective participation of his/her team in the various sites.

Bidders shall be issued a site visit certificate by the representative of the Deputy Project Owner at the end of the above-mentioned visits.

The pre-bidding meeting shall take place on 31 MAI 2024 at 7:0 in the conference room of the PAK 2-storey building in Kribi located next to MEAO Building.

Only bidders that went for the site visit will be allowed to take part in the pre-bidding meeting

10. Bid bond

Bids must be accompanied by a bid bond issued by a financial institution, or a first-rate banking institution approved by the Minister in charge of finance (see Document 11 in the Tender File) to be automatically released no later than 30 days after the expiry of the validity of the tenders and amounting to **six hundred and fifty thousand (650,000) CFAF**.

14. Admissibility of bids

Under penalty of rejection, administrative documents required must be provided in originals or copies certified by the issuing institution or the competent administrative authority in accordance with the provisions of the Specific Rules of the Call for Tenders.

They must have been issued less than three (3) months before the original date of submission of bids or after the signing date of the Tender File.

Any bid that is incomplete after the moratorium provided by the Internal Procurement Committee as per the prescriptions of the Tender File shall be considered inadmissible.



15. Opening of bids

The opening of bids shall take place in one stage.

The opening of administrative, technical and financial bids shall take place on 18 JUN 2024 at 1 p.m. prompt by the Internal Procurement Committee of the Port Authority of Kribi in the Conference Room of the PAK 2-storey building located next to MEAO Building in Kribi.

Only bidders or their duly mandated representatives shall attend this opening session.

16. Evaluation criteria

A. Eliminatory criteria

1- Insufficient number of copies (less than 7 copies)

2- Administrative file

- Non-compliant administrative document after the 48-hour deadline provided by the Internal Procurement Committee;
- Incomplete administrative file;
- False statement or forged document;

3- Technical file

- No site visit certificate;
- Non-acceptance of the terms and conditions of the contract (Technical Specifications, Special Administrative Specifications (CCAP), declaration of commitment to comply with the social and environmental clauses or Integrity Charter not initialled on each page, not signed, not sealed and not dated by the bidder on the last page);
- Non-compliance of three (3) key criteria out of five (5);
- False statement or forged document.

- No quantified unit price;
- No sub-details on quantified unit prices.
