1. Purpose of the Call for Tenders

The General Manager of the Port Authority of Kribi, Project Owner, hereby launches a call for tenders to recruit a consultant to carry out architectural and technical studies to build a modern multifunctional document information management complex (archives, library, museum) at PAK.

Nature of services

The services assigned to the Consultant shall include the following:

- Drawing up technical studies (written and graphic documents, site surveys, architectural, geotechnical and structural studies, Preliminary Summary Design, Detailed Preliminary Design, Construction Project, Detailed Technical Specifications, Tender Documents/Consultation Documents for construction and construction control works);
- Defining the main features and standardised functionalities of the archive conservation infrastructure;
- Defining the main features and standard functions of the media library infrastructure;
- Defining the main features and standardised functionalities of the infrastructure for the museum;
- Drawing up the Terms of Reference, specifying the technical requirements for each component.

These services shall aim to ensure that the material used and the works carried out have the characteristics to guarantee their durability.

2. Provisional execution time

The maximum time provided by the Project Owner to carry out the work shall be six (6) months.

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3. Allotment

This Call for Tenders shall not be divided.

4. Provisional cost

The provisional cost for the services shall be one hundred and seventy-five million (175,000,000) CFAF all tax inclusive.

5. Participation and origin

This Call for Tenders is open to Design firms incorporated under Cameroonian law.

6. Funding

Services covered by this Call for Tenders shall be funded by the PAK BUDGET, 2024 and following FYs and allocated as follows:

7. Bid bond

Bids must be accompanied by a bid bond issued by a financial institution or a first-rate banking institution approved by the Minister in charge of finance (see Document 11 in the Tender File) to be automatically released no later than 30 days after the expiry of the validity of the tenders and amounting to four million four hundred and twenty thousand (3,500,000) CFAF.

10. Submission of bids

11. Admissibility of bids

Under penalty of rejection, administrative documents required must be provided in originals or copies certified by the issuing institution or the competent administrative authority in accordance with the provisions of the Specific Rules of the Call for Tenders.

They must have been issued less than three (3) months before the original date of submission of bids or after the signing date of the Callf or Tenders.

Any bid that is incomplete after the moratorium provided by the internal Procurement Committee as per the prescriptions of the Tender File shall be considered inadmissible.

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12. Opening of bids

The opening of bids shall take place in two stages. Administrative and technical files shall be opened first, followed by the opening of the financial bids of bidders with the minimum required technical score.

The opening of administrative and technical files shall take place on at 1 p.m. by the Internal Procurement Committee of the Port Authority of Kribi in the Conference Room of the PAK 2-storey building in Kribi.

Bidders or their duly mandated representatives shall attend this bid-opening session.

Financial bids shall be opened after the technical analysis only for bidders with the minimum score of 80/100.

13. Evaluation criteria

A. Eliminatory criteria

1) Administrative file

- Incomplete administrative file;
- Non-compliant administrative document after the 48-hour deadline provided by the Internal Procurement Committee;
- False statement or forged document;
- Financial information found in the administrative file.

2) Technical file

- False statement or forged document;
- Financial information found in the technical file:
- No Terms of Reference (TOR), Special Administrative Specifications (CCAP), declaration of commitment to comply with the social and environmental clauses and Integrity Charter not initialled on each page, not signed, not sealed and not dated by the bidder on the last page;
- Technical score below 80/100.

3) Financial file

- No quantified unit price.

14. Selection method

The method used to select the services provider shall be based on quality and cost in accordance with the provisions of the Specific Regulations of the Call for Tenders, namely:

The respective weights assigned to the technical and financial bids are:

Weight of the technical bid (T) = 80%

Weight of the financial bid (F) = 20%

The overall score (Ng) of a bid is obtained by weighting the technical score (Nt) by the weight of the technical bid (T) and the financial score (Nf) by the weight of the financial bid (F) according to the following formula: $Ng = (Nt \times T + Nf \times F)$.

The bid with the highest overall score (Ng) shall be ranked as the "best bid". The other bids shall be ranked in descending order of overall scores.

15. Award

The contract shall be awarded to the bidder with the most competitive bid.

16. Validity of bids

Bidders shall be bound by their tenders for ninety (90) days with effect from the tender submission deadline.
